Sunday 1st July 2012 Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Wis 1.13-15, 2.23-24; Ps 29; Mk 5.21- 43

The reading from Wisdom makes the point that the devil's envy brought death into the world. We were made imperishable and in the image of God. The whole religious story is the restoration of the original destiny of mankind.

Today's psalm could be read in the context of the resurrection. We as the mystical body give thanks for our mourning having being changed to dancing and our destiny from those who sink into the grave.

St Paul talks of balance in our spiritual and domestic lives, our strengths and our weakness.

In today's Gospel we witness two lovely healings effected by Jesus. The first is the healing of the woman with the haemorrhage and the healing of a 12-year-old. The attitude of the supplicants is striking - faith. Both supplicants believed that the young man from Nazareth had the gift and power of healing. They acted on their belief; the woman may well have been timid or shy. But so deep was her conviction that she was sure that the mere touch of his garment was enough to cure her. The man felt it was necessary for Jesus to come, like a doctor, to the bedside of his daughter.

The exchange between Jesus and the woman shows just how aware Jesus is of the calls made on him. This should be a great comfort to us.


